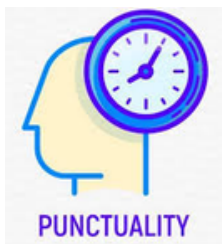

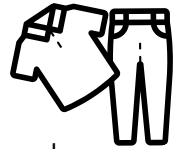
We look forward to welcoming our learners back on-site, Wednesday 3rd September.
